Bank Identification Code (Swift BIC): Full 11 character BIC required – if 8 characters last 3 = XXX

NOTES FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY:

1) Payments to Personkonto accounts with Nordea Bank previously made to bank code 3782 should now be made to bank code 3300.

2) Use only 3300 as a bank code if the beneficiary account is 10 digits for Nordea bank.

3) For Swedbank/ FöreningsSparbanken (8000-8999), the clearing number may consist of five digits. The fifth digit in the clearing number should be omitted.

4) The 9-digit account number should be padded with leading zero to make the string valid for Rule 4.

5) The 8-digit account number should be padded with two leading zeroes to make the string valid for Rule 3.

6) While deriving the Beneficiary Account and Bank code from IBAN check the length of the beneficiary account number against the Bank code.

7) Modulus is mandatory for Sweden and different rules are applicable as per the bank.
