TEACHERS' SUPERANNUATION (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS VALUATION

The valuation report for the period 2001 – 2005 has now been completed and the full report can be viewed at <u>www.sppa.gov.uk</u>

Employers will wish to note that the report recommends an increase in the employer's contributions from 13.5% to 14.9%.

The main factors underlying the increase in contribution rates are -

- Increases in life expectancy
- Increases in ill health and early retirement.

The Scottish Government has accepted the recommendation contained in the report and accordingly you are asked to make the necessary change in the employer's contribution rate from 1 April 2009.
