**THE TEACHERS' SUPERANNUATION (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS
PROVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES TO SPPA**

Teachers' Superannuation Circular 2003/2 issued on 19 September 2003 advised of a change in the provider of medical advisory services to SPPA.

In the Circular it was stated that employers were to ensure that fully completed Form Awards 27, part 1, 2 and (MED) were to be collated by them prior to being submitted to SPPA. That was incorrect. If the scheme member wishes, he or she can send the Form Awards 27, part 2 directly to SPPA, as was previously indicated in Teachers' Superannuation Circular No. 2002/1, issued on 30 January 2002. The form does **not** have to be returned to the member's employer.
