SUBJECT:	PUBLIC SERVICE PENSIONS INCREASE 2010
DATE:	23 March 2010

The purpose of this circular is to notify Pension Managers and Superannuation Sections that there will be no increase to Public Service Pensions this year.

Public service pensions will not be uprated from April 2010, i.e. benefits will remain at current cash levels. This is in line with the uprating of additional pensions (State Earnings Related Pension and State Second Pension), as the increase in the Retail Prices Index in the 12 months to September 2009 was negative (-1.4%).

As there is no increase this year, there will be no Pensions Increase (Review) Order 2010. The Public Service Pensions Uprate 2010 multiplier tables and associated covering note have been published on the HM Treasury website: Public Service Pension Uprating 2010.
