# Consultation on The NHS Superannuation and Pension Scheme (Scotland) Amendment (No.2) Regulations

I attach for your consideration and comment, a copy of the draft regulations which will amend the National Health Service (Scotland) Superannuation Regulations 2011 (the 1995 section) and the National Health Service (Scotland) Pension regulations 2008 (the 2008 section).

# Summary of the Changes

Employee Contribution tables contained within the regulations have been updated to reflect the NHS pay award effective from 1 April 2013. Revised tables are inserted in the regulations which will be applicable to officer members changing employment within the scheme year or new starters. The revised tables will also be applicable to practitioners and non GP partners whose contributions are based on current year income. The tables insert new pay/earnings bands only and do not increase the percentage of contributions payable. Further details are contained in the attached annex.

# **Explanation of Amending Regulations**

## Changes to the pay/earnings bands for the 2013/14 scheme year

- 1. Member contribution rates in the NHS Superannuation Scheme are determined by reference to pensionable pay/earnings in a scheme year. Officer member contributions are generally based on the previous years earnings however if they change job in year or are new into the scheme their contribution is based on estimated whole time whole year earnings in their current employment. Practitioners and non GP providers contributions are based on their aggregated income from all sources in the current year.
- 2. As a consequence of the recent pay freeze, the tiered contribution regulations currently consist of a one-table format for existing and new entrant officer members and a two-table format for GP and non-GP Provider members.
- 3. In order to reflect the recent pay award which applies for the scheme year 1 April 2013 to 31 March 2014 for all members, the relevant regulations are updated to include a new uprated table for officer members and an uprated existing 'table 2' for Practitioner and non-GP Provider members.
- 4. The proposed amendments to regulations will come into force from June 2013 and have retrospective effect to 1 April 2013. The amendments are wholly beneficial in that they increase the threshold of pensionable pay/earnings required to determine the level of member contributions payable. The changes will insert new pay/earnings thresholds only; there is no increase in the percentage of contributions payable and no change to the way the tables are used.
- 5. SPPA circular <u>2013/04</u> gives more detailed information on how the tables are applied and this will be updated shortly to reflect these changes.
