THE TEACHERS' SUPERANNUATION (ADDITIONAL VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS) (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 2009

I attach, for any comments that you may have, a draft of the Teachers' Superannuation (Additional Voluntary Contributions) (Scotland) Regulations 2009. Responses by Friday, 10 October 2008 would be appreciated.

These Regulations consolidate the Teachers' Superannuation (Additional Voluntary Contributions) (Scotland) Regulations 1995, which have been amended substantially since that date. They make minor and drafting alterations only and do not make any changes of substance.

Comments on the draft Teachers' Superannuation (Additional Voluntary Contributions) (Scotland) Regulations 2009 should be made in writing to me at the above address. Tables of Derivations and Destinations are also attached which identify individual regulations in the 2009 consolidated Regulations with the equivalent provisions in the superseded Regulations and vice versa.
