SUBJECT: TIERED CONTRIBUTION RATE SYSTEM

Local Government Pension Scheme in Scotland

Version 10 - issued 11 March 2016

About Circular No.4/2016:-

The purpose of this circular is to notify all interested parties of the release of Version 10 of the guidance on the tiered contribution rate system for the Local Government Pension Scheme in Scotland.

Under regulation 9(3)(a) of The Local Government Pension Scheme (Scotland) Regulations 2014, the earnings ranges used to determine annual contribution rates



are to be increased each year by any increase applied to pensions under the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971, and are to be treated for the purposes of paragraph 3(a) as if they were pensions beginning on 1st April 2014. As communicated in Circular 3/2016, in the 12 months to September 2015, CPI was negative (-0.1%), and no inflationary increase is to be applied from 1 April 2016 for either pensions in payment or deferred pensions, with both remaining frozen at their current level of payment or deferred value. As a result, no inflationary increase is to be applied from 1 April 2016 to the employee contribution bandings for 2016/17.

Please find attached Version 10 of the guidance on the operation of the tiered contribution rate system for the Local Government Pension Scheme in Scotland.

This version replaces version 9 which was issued in March 2015.

Changes to the guidance are as follows:

- Annex C Table 1 Tiered Contribution Pay Rates. References to 2015/16 have been updated to 2016/17.
- Annex C Table 2 Look Up Table for 2015/2016. References to 2015/16 have been updated to 2016/17.

Administering Authorities are asked to ensure that Version 10 of the guidance is forwarded to LGPS employers.
