# 1. Welcome and Apologies

- 1.1 The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and led introductions.
- 1.2 All confirmed that they had no conflicts of interest.

# 2. Minutes of the meeting held on 5 October 2020

#### Paper 2a – Draft SAB minutes of 5 October 2020

2.1 The Chair discussed the minutes. Alan Robertson asked for the drafting notes to be removed at 2.4, 3.18 and 3.39. Greg Walker agreed that this would be done. The minutes were agreed.

# Paper 2b – Action Log

- 2.2 Greg Walker confirmed there was nothing to report on action point 2019/05, he will commit to make progress on this before the next meeting.
- 2.3 Greg Walker gave an update on action point 2020/01. Greg advised that deferred members do not currently have access to my pension online system. However when the new system goes live it is hoped that access can be extended to deferred members.
- 2.4 George Russell gave an update on action point 2020/02 to provide an example of member choice (legacy or reformed scheme) for a 1995 Scheme under McCloud, where the reformed scheme would be better and confirmed the document would be circulated very shortly.
- 2.5 Greg confirmed that the joint SAB meeting with HMT on McCloud had taken place on 22 September 2020 and the action is therefore complete. Alan Robertson highlighted that it was a very useful meeting.

#### 3. McCloud Consultation

<u>Paper 3a – Public service pension schemes: changes to the transitional arrangements to the</u> 2015 schemes – Employer side response to consultation questions

#### Consultation.

- 3.1 The discussion then moved on to the main purpose of the meeting, the SAB's response to HMT's consultation the McCloud remedy. Derek Lindsay highlighted that Greg Walker had issued a draft response for SAB consideration and a number of SAB members had fed back with suggested amendments. The SAB agreed that Greg Walker should talk through each of the consultation questions with a view to refining the SAB's response.
- 3.2 The SAB had a full discussion around the response to each consultation question and all comments were noted by the Secretariat for inclusion in the SAB response.

3.3 Greg Walker committed to review the SAB consultation response and to amend the draft in line with the outcome of discussions on each question. Once updated, Greg will circulate to the SAB for final agreement before submitting the response.
