The Teachers' Pension Scheme (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 2024

Coming into force	1 April 2024

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and (2)(d) and 3 of, and paragraph 4(b) of schedule 2 of, the Public Service Pensions Act 2013(**a**) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 21(1) of that Act, the Scottish Ministers consulted the representatives of such persons as appeared to them likely to be affected by these Regulations.

In accordance with section 3(5) of that Act, these Regulations are made with the consent of the Treasury.

Citation, commencement and effect

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Teachers' Pension Scheme (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 2024, come into force on 1 April 2024 and have effect from 1 April 2024.

Amendment of the Teachers' Pension Scheme (Scotland) (No. 2) Regulations 2014

2. The Teachers' Pension Scheme (Scotland) (No. 2) Regulations 2014(**b**) are amended in accordance with regulation 3 and 4.
